

General Documents for All Applicants

- Valid passport (with at least 6 months before expiry)
- Completed visa application form
- Passport-sized photos (meeting embassy's specifications)
- Proof of funds (bank statements, pay slips, or sponsorship letters)
- Proof of travel insurance
- Visa fee payment receipt
- Appointment confirmation letter

Student Visa Checklist (2025)

- University/college admission letter
- Proof of tuition fee payment (if applicable)
- Proof of accommodation arrangements
- Academic transcripts and certificates
- Language proficiency test results (IELTS, TOEFL, etc.)
- Statement of purpose (SOP) or study plan
- Financial documents showing ability to cover tuition & living expenses

Work Visa Checklist (2025)

- Job offer or employment contract from an approved employer
- Proof of professional qualifications or licenses
- CV/resume
- Work reference letters (if required)
- Employer's sponsorship documents (if applicable)
- Police clearance certificate
- Medical examination results (depending on country)

Visitor/Travel Visa Checklist (2025)

- Round-trip flight booking or itinerary
- Hotel reservations or invitation letter from a host
- Proof of financial means to support stay
- Travel insurance covering medical emergencies
- Letter explaining purpose of visit (if required)

Extra Tips for 2025 Visa Applications

- Start early: Many embassies have longer processing times post-COVID. Apply 2–3 months in advance.
- Double-check requirements: Each country has unique rules - always confirm with the official embassy website.
- Keep copies: Store both digital and printed copies of all documents.
- Be honest: Never submit false documents; it could lead to a permanent ban.
